



**The new STDP website is up and running! This interactive site serves both a data-entry and research function. If you are involved in a current STDP-funded project, you can now file progress and final reports on-line through the site. As well, anyone can use the site's "Tech Finder" interface to search the STDP project database.**

- Project Number
- Forest Health Protection (STDP Project) Lead
- Pest Type
- Host Type
- Forest Service Region
- Year

**Since its inception in 1990, STDP has funded more than 200 projects. Technically, the data from these projects has always been available to the public. But until the advent of this site, all**

**the information was in hardcopy reports, and there was no practical way for anyone outside FHP to access them. Now researchers can use the Internet and access the on-line STDP project database, which includes hundreds of pages of project data from 1998 forward. Included in the database is data from projects dealing with risk assessments, semiochemical evaluations, demonstrations of integrated pest management techniques, simulation and visualization models of insect and pathogen impacts, development of pest control techniques, and evaluations of management tools such as prescribed burning, spraying, and thinning.**
